Variance of title units in the Zvenyhorod Card Index by A. Yu. Krymsky

Abstract

The article updates the issue of the living language as a linguistic source, in particular for the lexicographic codification of usus; lexical material important for the renewal of Ukrainian identity is considered – a fragment of the Zvenihorod Card Index A. Yu. Krymskyi (ZCI) as a component of the lexical and illustrative basis of the "Russian-Ukrainian Dictionary" edited by A. Yu. Krymsky and S. O. Efremov (1924–1933). The features of variants – lexical (сѣменное дерево / сѣянецъ / самосѣвъ = сіянка, суетня / сутолока / хлопоты = крутани́на), phonetic (клечіння / клечання), accentuation (сійба / сійба), morphological (связь / связность) – are clarified both at the level of microstructure (as part of the title element) and at the level of the macrostructure of the ZCI (as the title word); derived title word are described.

The presence of variants (even crossed out) of the title word is inherent primarily to the Russian counterpart. The variant evidence about: a) the search for the most optimal counterpart and synonyms for the Ukrainian unit; b) reflection of the components of the semantic structure of the Ukrainian word. The macro structure of the card file attests to the connection of the register at the level of source / derived units, illustrated by vivid material.
